
Charity Fund Saves Lives!


Good day to you and the entire Faile Foundation. My name is Denis Azabra Awuni a native of Nalerigu. I have been touched by a gesture the foundation has done to my family and I want to stand on behalf of the entire family and say a very big thank you. The foundation gave my family the biggest ever Christmas Gift by saving the life of my brother's son through financial and spiritual support.

To state the facts clear, my brother's son's name is Mubarik Awuni; he was admitted at BMC in Nalerigu on the 20th of December 2015. The condition got worse and demanded a referral to Konfo Anokye Teaching Hospital Kumasi for a CT scan and other investigations that could not be readily done at BMC. His condition was critical and required the services of an ambulance which we could not afford.

The foundation stepped in and provided financial support to cater for the ambulance and the coordinator (Rev. Francis) made necessary contacts at the receiving facility for us and even accompanied the patient to the hospital. At the hospital the foundation paid for the necessary bills and even gave the boy feeding allowances. We were put on very expensive antibiotics and the

Cahill Family Staying


